	Interest in improving care for adolescent patients (ages 12-24) Ability to assemble a Team that consists of (at least) a provider, practice manager, and 1-3 other key staff members (such as an MA, social worker, or nurse) to support the project Willingness to commit 1-4 hours per month throughout the 18-month process
Data C	ollection (takes place during a 3-month baseline and again during a 3-month year-end timeframe): Ability to collect approximately 50 youth surveys from adolescent patients either electronically or on paper (surveys will be provided in English and in Spanish) Ability to survey all staff and providers at the target site on knowledge and attitudes on state minor consent laws as well as perceptions of youth friendliness at their clinic (survey will be provided electronically) Ability to pull one year of clinic-level patient outcome data including adolescent-specific quality (HEDIS) data on chlamydia screening, HPV vaccination, well visit, and depression screening Willingness to participate in 2, 2-hour self-assessments facilitated by the AFHP Team
	sional Development and Capacity-Building: Willingness to participate in a 1-hour Orientation Webinar Willingness to participate in 2 full-day Summits and 2 half-hour check-in calls
