The ACM is a structured, evidence-based program that removes barriers and transforms adolescent care. The ACM helps clinics evaluate, enhance, and sustain best practices, creating environments where adolescents feel respected, supported, and empowered.

Pre-Implementation Period (3 Months)



Baseline Data Collection

Youth and staff surveys, along with HEDIS measures, help identify areas for improvement in adolescent care. ACE-AP Self-Assessment helps identify priority areas for customized plan to enhance policies and practices.

Implementation Period (12 Months)



Summits

Two full-day in-person training sessions to build community of practice and equip Champion Teams with knowledge and skills improve adolescent care.



Core Content Modules

Three interactive, self-directed learning modules on youth-friendly care, adolescent brain development, confidentiality, and cultural responsiveness.



Sparks Modules

Six short, engaging staff trainings designed to create conversations and small changes in clinic workflows.



Check-in Calls

Two one-on-one coaching sessions with ACM support team for status check, guidance, and troubleshooting.

Post-Implementation Period (3 Months)



Year-End Data Collection

Surveys and HEDIS measures quantify impact of the ACM on environment, policies, practices, and culture. ACE-AP Self-Assessment guides continuous improvement.



Adolescent-Centered Certification

Health centers that complete the model are eligible for certification.
